**GUIDELINES: 2017 Photography Exhibition**  
**Please read all guidelines carefully as some have changed.**

1. To participate, please register no later than May 1<sup>st</sup>, and submit images of your works before May 15<sup>th</sup> to Andrew Sarrasin at [aws@moumtroyalcem.com](mailto:aws@moumtroyalcem.com).
2. Please note photos are to be installed from 4p.m. to 7 p.m. on Friday May 26<sup>th</sup> and removed immediately following the exhibition. Under some circumstances you may be permitted to install Saturday morning.
3. Participants may display a maximum of 6 photos; all works must respect the theme and be original to this exhibition; at least one photo must be taken in the Mount Royal Cemetery with those from other cemeteries not eligible for awards.
4. To respect the integrity of the cemetery and its clientele, identification of family names on monuments is to be avoided; nudity or similar content is not permitted.
5. Photographers will be provided with one 4' x 8' panel and hooks for hanging your works; we ask that you refrain from using any materials that may cause damage to the panels and your works.
6. For safety and aesthetic reasons side tables are not permitted; albums and small items may be displayed only on tables in the adjacent area.
7. Photos are to be a minimum of 48 square inches (i.e.: 6" x 8", 4" x 12", 3" x 16"); regardless of size, all photos must be on a 16" x 20" black or white matt or cardboard. Framed photos will not be accepted.
8. You may describe all photos together on an 8.5in. x 11in. sheet of paper and include a short bio on the same paper if you wish. Please identify each photo on a 5cm x 9cm (2in. x 3.5in.) card listing the number and title as well as the price if the photo is for sale.
9. Works that are sold must remain on display for the duration of the exhibition.
10. Participants are solely responsible for the safety of their prints and personal items.
11. The "*Friends of the Mount Royal Cemetery*" will not publish your photos without your permission.
