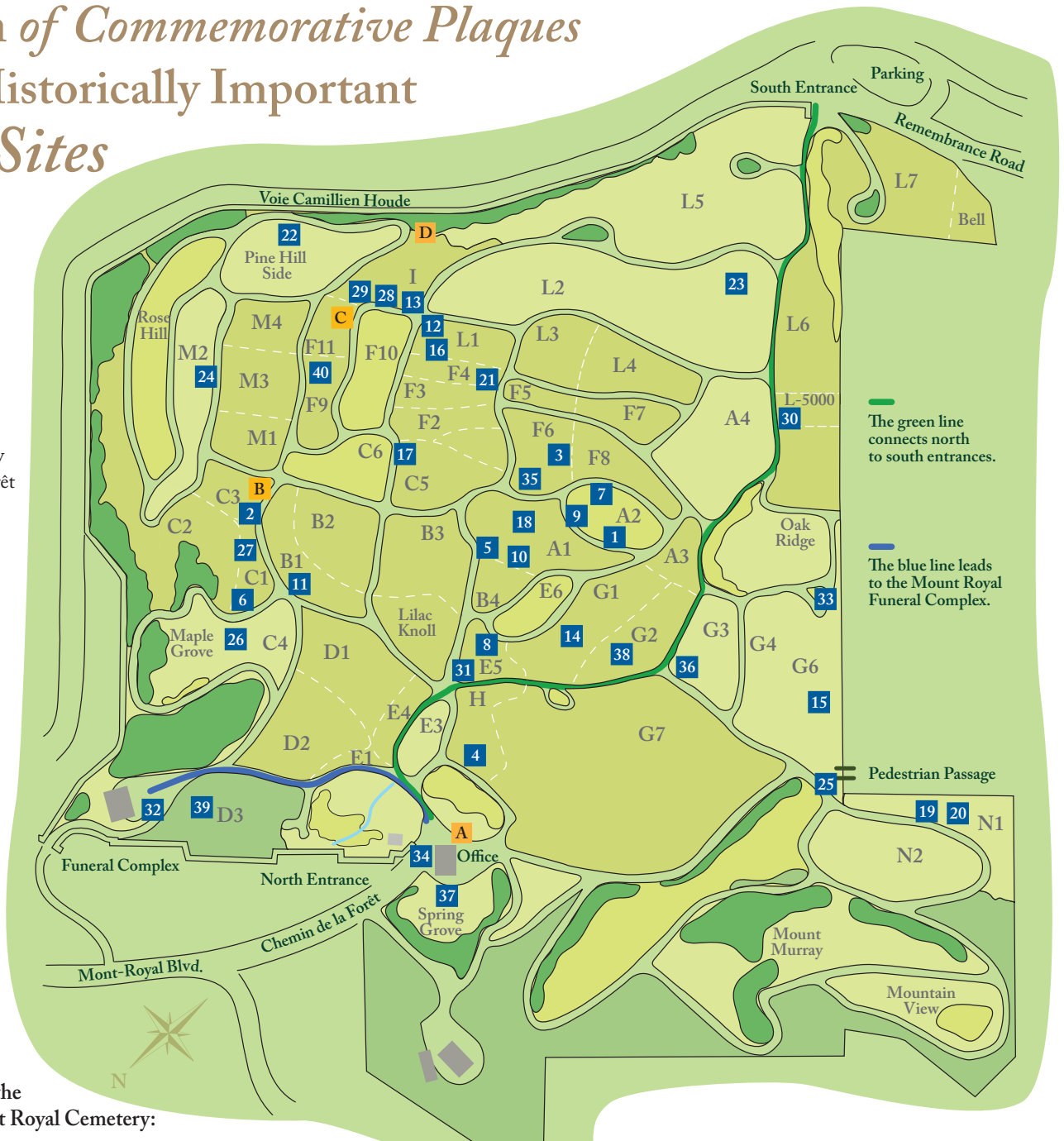


Location of Commemorative Plaques on Historically Important Burial Sites
